

Preparing your 4-H Exhibits for the 2022 State Fair

Exhibit Entries:

All exhibits (except crops and gardens) must be brought to the State Fairgrounds in the Deseret Building between **9:00 AM and 1:00 PM** on **Thursday, September 1st**.

Each county must sign up for a designated time to drop off your entries:

Please have your crops and gardens exhibits to the 4-H Building at the State Fair **between 12:00 PM and 2:00 PM on Wednesday, September 7th**.

Entries:

All entries must be entered online using the 4-H Online Fair Manager –
<https://countyfair.usu.edu/>

Please make sure the descriptions are complete and can help distinguish the item.

Fruits, vegetables, and vegetable creatures do not have to compete at the County Level first because of the various growing seasons, but they must be State Fair quality.

A member will be allowed to enter more than one exhibit per class, but **no more than one exhibit per lot within the class**. Exceptions to this rule are Food Preservation (3 bottles of different fruit and three bottles of different vegetables are allowed) and Gardening.

Exhibit Entry Tags:

Each exhibit must have an exhibit tag securely attached. Exhibit tags are to be a maximum of 4 inches across and 3 inches long.

Each county is encouraged to make a unique exhibit tag.

Information to be included on the exhibit tags:

- Name of 4-H member (large enough to read from a distance of 3 feet)
- County
- Grade
- Class and Lot number
- Item Description

***Please leave one of the bottom corners empty so that the judges may attach the ribbon.

Exhibits with more than one part must have an exhibit card attached to each part numbered 1 of 3, 2 of 3, 3 of 3, etc.

Please bring at least 3 additional blank exhibit tag sheets when exhibits are entered so that we can replace damaged cards if needed.

County Exhibit Lists:

Counties are required to turn in 2 exhibit lists on State Fair Entry Day.

Exhibitor Passes:

Counties are required to turn in mailing labels on State Fair Entry Day for their youth exhibiting at the State Fair. A congratulatory letter and complimentary gate admission ticket will then be mailed to each exhibitor (1 ticket per exhibitor, not 1 per exhibit). The tickets are good for entry on any day of the State Fair. Please ensure that addresses are correct.

Exhibit Pick-up:

Exhibits may be picked up between **12:00 PM and 3:00 PM** on **Monday, September 19th**.
