4-H PATHWAY

The four components of the Pathway provide intentional and progressive education and leadership skills for youth of all ages.



EXPLORE FIND THE "SPARK"

Youth who are exposed to the opportunity to connect their passions in 4-H with a potential career and education in the future can develop early interest in specific areas of study and industries.

LEARN CAMPS, EVENT, OPPORTUNITIES

Career Readiness training should be infused into project-based learning to improve youth's understanding, reduce intimidation, and maintain interest.

PRACTICE 4-H CLUBS & CONTESTS

Youth should be given opportunities to further explore options before making big decisions. Examples include working with mentors during 4-H club meetings, or speaking to industry professionals during 4-H contests.

EXPERIENCE CAREER PATHWAYS

Real-world training opportunities are key. 4-H youth should seek internships and service learning experiences related to their career interests.

SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES

Service opportunities are abundant and should relate directly to the youth's interest in postsecondary education and career options. Working in real-world scenarios can be a tremendous help while youth are exploring their opportunities, while also serving others. Examples may be found on 4-H project specific sheets.

LEADERSHIP

There are many opportunities to serve as a youth leader in 4-H from the club to national level, all of which are tremendous learning opportunities and often the first step toward building a resume. On the state level, there are leadership opportunities directly related to Career Readiness by serving as a Teen or Collegiate Leader at 4-H University.

4-H PROJECTS

4-H gives youth an opportunity to explore different career paths, learn and practice new skills, and experience what a career in a related field may be like. This is achieved by allowing youth to participate in a large assortment of project areas and contests.

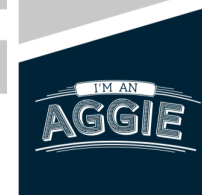
