



Fashion Revue

WHAT TO EXPECT

Orientation:

- An orientation will be held with all contestants. During the orientation the superintendent will review the contest rules, discuss procedures for the personal interview and a group photo will be taken. Detailed instruction for the public fashion revue will be given at this time. All participants will have the opportunity practice modeling on stage and presenting their personal introduction.

Personal Interview:

- Contestants will meet for a personal interview with the judges. During the interview, the contestant will be judged on: their oral presentation skills, the content of their oral presentation, the appearance of outfit/garment, and to questions from the judges. Judges will complete the first 4 sections of the scoresheet during the interview.
- During the interview contestants will have the opportunity to provide an oral presentation in front of the judges. Presentation should be in the following format:
 1. Name
 2. One—two minutes or less presentation about their 4-H Clothing and Textiles project. This oral presentation can include information about the garment being modeled, learning experiences or activities in the clothing and textiles project, future plans and any other information related to their 4-H career.

Following the oral presentation the judges will have the opportunity to ask questions. The judges are given a pre-determined set of questions. Questions asked will relate to the oral presentation, 4-H clothing and textiles project experiences and clothing and textiles subject matter.

Public Fashion Revue:

- Contestants will participate in a public fashion revue where they will have an opportunity to model in a way to showcase their outfit/garment. Judges will score each of the participants on their modeling skills. Each participant will be required to introduce themselves during the public fashion revue.

Additional Information:

- Spectators and coaches are not allowed in to the interview portion of the contest. Spectators and coaches are welcome to attend the public Fashion Revue portion of the contest.
- There are 2-3 judges for the contest who are knowledgeable about the subject matter. Judges will use the Western National Roundup Fashion Revue Evaluation Form.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS FOR COACHES:

- Contestant order will be determined by a random drawing and announced at the coaches meeting.
- Awards will be announced at the FCS Classic Awards Breakfast, and the top five(5) contestants will be recognized.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS FOR CONTESTANTS:

- Outfits/Garments can be constructed, modified, or purchased. All outfits/garments will be judged against each other. At the discretion of the contest officials, categories maybe added if enough participation warrants additional categories.
- Wear your garment to the Fashion Revue orientation.
