

4-H Utah Shooting Sports County Competition information and instructions for 2022

The County Competition are for the Counties to decide which youth from their county will participate in the State Shooting Sports Contest.

To Participate in the 2022 4-H Shooting Sports Contest read the following:

How to Sign-Up Youth for Contest:

- Individual Counties will hold their own county contest to decide who will come to the State Contest.
 - Eligible youth from 8 years old to 18 years old can attend the state shoot.
 - To continue to the National Competition on June 26 – July 1, 2022, you must be 14 years of age before January 1, 2022.
 - Youth must have their Hunter Education Certification Completed to compete at State.
 - All youth must be registered in 4H.
 - **The Cost for each youth will be \$20**

Dates of the Mail in Competition: **August 1, 2021 to April 15, 2022**

- You will have from **Aug 1, 2021 to April 15, 2022** to complete the Shotgun & Rifle and Archery.
- **Registration for the 4H Shooting Sport State Contest will begin Feb 16, 2022 on 4H.zsuite.org**
- **Shotgun** and **Rifle** and **Archery** Competition will take place within your local area and at your local Shooting ranges.
- **Youth can choose to Shoot One, two or all three events.**
 - Example: Tom only wants to shoot shotgun, and Mary wants to shoot archery and .22 rifle. Jerry would like to shoot rifle, shotgun and archery.

Shotgun Contest Instruction:

- If your county does not have an official trap or skeet course in your area. The trap and skeet courses can be set up with what the county has for equipment to be similar to trap and skeet.
 - Each youth will Shoot **2 rounds of 25 Trap** equaling 50 shots
 - Each youth will Shoot **2 rounds of 25 Skeet** equaling 50 shots
 - Upon completion Leaders decide who will attend the state contest.
- As the state is still growing in number of competitors you are welcome to bring all your youth who would like to compete as long as they are familiar and capable of completing the contest in the events. Rifle, Archery, Shotgun.

Rifle Contest Instruction:

- The youth that are participating will use the included targets to shoot the following.
 - All shooting will be at your local ranges or closest one near you.
 - Each youth will shoot a silhouette target at 20 ft in the Standing Position
 - The target is a TQ-14-50
 - One shot per silhouette with a total of 20 shots per paper
 - You can print out copies of this or similar pages to shoot.



- **NRA 3 Position Contest:**

- Each youth will shoot at a A-51 target at 25 yards
- If you do not have the available targets you may print your own.

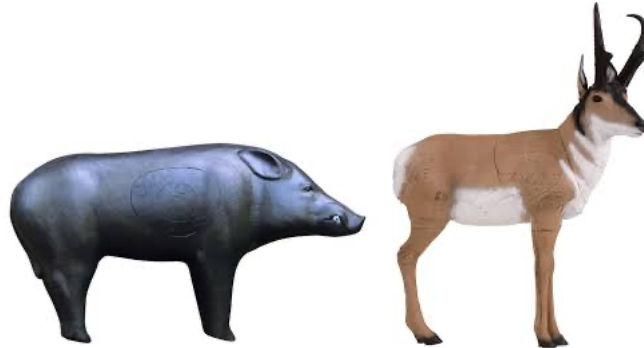


- The youth will shoot 5 shots at each bull for the total of 20 shots
 - The top two targets are practice bulls
- 5 shots in the top left target below the line in the standing position
- 5 shots in the bottom left target in the kneeling position
- 5 shots in the top right target below the line from the sitting position
- 5 shots in the bottom right target from the prone position

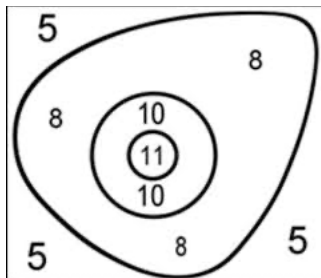
Archery Contest Instructions:

- **ARCHERY 3D SHOOT:**

- Youth will shoot 10 - 3D animal targets at unknown distances ranging from 10yard to 50 yards
- Leaders will determine distances and animal. You may also use regular targets if no 3D targets are available.



- Youth will shoot ONE arrow at each of the 10 – 3D targets which resembles archery Hunting where you may only get one shot in the wild.
- Scoring will be as in the following picture, if the arrow hit a line the score goes to the higher score to be recorded.



ARCHERY FIELD TARGET SHOOT

- Youth will shoot 3 field targets as seen below:



- Scoring will be 5 points center black / white equal 4 points and outer black equals 3 points
- Youth will shoot 3 arrows at 3 different distances
 - One target at 20 yards
 - One target at 30 yards
 - One target at 45 yards.

ARCHERY FITA TARGET SHOOT:

- Youth will shoot at 50 yards the target below

- Youth will shoot 3 arrows and shoot 3 ends or times for a total of 9 arrows to score from.
- More instruction will be announced at actual event.

Upon completion of the archery shoot totals will be calculated and the leaders will decide who goes to the state contest.

Youth will be divided into three groups in all three events.

Jr = 9, 10, 11
Inter = 12,13
Senior = 14-18
