Information Presented

Kirt Enwright—gave a report on the lek counts and surveys for 2002&2003. In the past the DWR only counted 29 leks/year. In 02/03 many other leks were counted and re visited. 20 new ones were found. We are right at 90 leks some are still unknown as far as activity 936 birds were counted this year. 186 (two bird permits) limited entry permits were issued in 2002. 60% success just over 200 birds were harvested. DWR got over 100 wings in their barrel surveys. 125 man days by the DWR is scheduled for lek surveys in west BE county. They are going to recommend 431 two bird permits to be issued this year.
