Trying to tie in the field tour into the WRI tour. We'll keep the group posted on the details of that. Next meeting will be September.

Alton Coal Development and Nicki Frey have contracted to continue research for 5 years. We'll be purchasing transmitters this summer and hopefully putting them on this fall.

Dog Valley research going well. 10 transmitters put out, but lost four birds in the first month. 3 definitely to mortality. 15
