There are now seven projects that cut across elements to Future Desired Condition. These projects will begin implementation in 2013 and 2014.

1. Programmatic Pinyon/Juniper Control
2. Reservoir Suitability Analysis
3. Winter Rangeland Improvement (Change with wording on cheat grass and disagreement with winter range not being able to be approached on large scale as the Junipers were)
4. Coordinated Weed Management (County Map GIP should keep track of treatment and keep database)
5. Other "Special-Status Species" Wildlife Protections
6. Community and Economic Development through Increased Visitation

We will have committees to see the projects will move forward. We need to contact all involved with the CRMP to have volunteers to help with the propose projects.
