

Notes for the July 16, 2013 CRMP Meeting

Clint had a map of Dry Basin showing the area where the work is to be done and the proposed Fire breaks, Juniper Treatments and Pipeline Extension. Troy suggested we make the plan bigger and more inclusive. He thought that Badger flats be added to the project. Jay made the motion to go ahead with this proposal, Troy seconded the proposal with the amendments. The voting members voted unanimously in favor of the plan.

Discussion about the burning of the downed P/J ensued. We will work on extending the window of opportunity to get the burning accomplished so we don't have so many areas unusable.

The board also voted on the artwork Wallace Keck from City of Rocks sent to use on highway 30 signage.

The State is still coming up to the Grouse Creek area about once a week to work on our Raven problem.

Ken Spackman suggested that there are some changes that need to be made in our voting board for the CRMP. We will meet in September to make those changes.
