In review of state fish and wildlife agency response to wind power siting, it is apparent that this is a relatively new issue for most agencies and that the majority can provide suggestions to developers but most existing guidelines are voluntary. Some states' guidelines were developed primarily by fish and wildlife agency and focused entirely on wildlife issues, while others included wildlife recommendations among guidelines ranging from public safety and recreational considerations to sound and visual impacts.
