The Fat Quarter Design Challenge is a crossover STEM contest between engineering and textile production. This contest challenges you to create a design to fill a need, and enter it into our design challenge.

Upon registration, a Fat Quarter will be provided to you from our Office. Deliver your entry to the 4-H Office by the deadline. You must also submit an artist statement. See ZSuite for instructions.

What is a Fat Quarter?

A Fat Quarter is a piece of fabric cut 18" off the end of the bolt, and then cut in half on the fold. Four of these put together still make up 1 yard of fabric. A fat quarter is usually 18" x 21" of fabric.

Jr. Livestock Education Tests

- This online contest runs October through July
- Every month there is a test for each species: beef, sheep, swine, & goats
- All of the questions for the test come from Ohio State University's resource handbooks which are available for purchase from the 4-H office for around \$30 each, depending on the species
- Each month's test will focus on a different chapter, or two, of the handbooks (see the schedule below)
- The test questions are a combination of true/false, multiple choice, and fill-in-the-blank
- Tests are open book with a time limit of 30 minutes
- Tests will close the last day of each month
- At the end of the contest, awards are given for each species in each age division

How to take the tests:

- Youth must be in 3rd-12th grade
- Youth must be enrolled in 4-H with fees paid
- Log in to [ZSuite](#)
- Click on "Events"
- Search for "Livestock Education Tests" to find the current month's test
- Select test
- Youth can take the tests for all 4 species
- Youth DO NOT have to be raising that species to take a test
