Registration and Patterns

- The cost is \$15 to register for a show
- Registration will close 9 days prior to each show
- Patterns will be sent out after show registration closes

Tests

- Weber County 4-H Horse tests will be administered online. The testing window will open the next business day after show registration ends and will close at 5pm the business day before the show. This timeframe should be adjusted to give the exhibitors approximately 8 days to test.
- The test will have a 20-minute time limit and be open book
- Tests are scored on a 30-point scale and include bonus questions for tie-breakers only
- Test scores will be converted to a 15-point scale for show points
- All exhibitors must have completed the test by the test closing deadline
- Test Review: Youth may review their tests for 24 hours after scores are released. All scores will be final 24 hours after scores are released.
