## **Utah Junior Turkey Show Additional Information and Rules**

(Please read carefully)

- 1. Because of the UDAF exemption rules related to poultry slaughter, youth and parents understand that all turkeys must be marketed through the Utah Junior Turkey Show and invoiced to the end consumer by the 4-H or FFA member, including those retained for personal use. Members keep the proceeds from their sales and to the Utah Jr. Turkey Show. Once sold to the end consumer, however, birds cannot be resold.
- 2. Poult Order Registration Forms must be filled out completely and appropriately signed by your FFA Advisor or Extension Agent. All forms and payment must arrive to the Utah Junior Turkey Show on or before May 3, 2021. <u>No late forms will be accepted.</u> If your County does a group registration submission through your FFA Chapter or Extension Office, it is recommended they be turned in to your county agent/FFA advisor on or before April 26<sup>th</sup>, 2021 so that they can be submitted to the Utah Junior Turkey Show by the official May 3 deadline. <u>Regardless of how orders are placed, all forms and payment</u> <u>must arrive to the Utah Junior Turkey Show on or before May 3, 2021. There will be no exceptions.</u>
- 3. Poults will be available for pick up TENTATIVELY on Friday, July 30<sup>th</sup>. *This is subject to change.*
- 4. Participants may order up to 20 poults.
- 5. Cost for each poult will be \$3.50 (Make payment to the Utah Junior Turkey Show):

- 6. Each exhibitor must turn in a completed 4-H portfolio or FFA record book to their 4-H County Agent or to their FFA Advisor. Completion of this requirement is verified by the signature of the 4-H County Agent or FFA Advisor at the bottom of the Processing and Registration Form that is generally due the first part of November. In addition, Exhibitors may choose to participate in the 4-H/FFA Record Book Contest. Contest entries must be turned in by 2:00 p.m. on Thursday of the State Turkey Show. Both 4-H and FFA Portfolio/Record Books will be submitted online. Participation in the show is not a prerequisite for submitting a record book.
- 7. Only Grade "A" turkeys will be sold at the state auction. Grade "A" is defined as a processed carcass with no missing body parts (such as wings, legs, etc.) and no skin missing. Physical damage to a bird during processing will not be reason for a quality downgrade.
- 8. A dressed tom must weigh a minimum of 16 pounds and a dressed hen must weigh a minimum of 12 pounds to be considered for the show and auction.
- 9. The turkey show will be held November 11-13, 2021. Processing fees may increase.
