Alyssum = *Lobularia maritima*

Cosmos Sensation = *Asteraceae bipinnatus*

Globe Amaranth = *Gomphrena*

Flowering Tobacco = *Nicotiana x sanderae*

Portulaca = *Portulacaceae grandiflora*

Morning Glory Vine = *Ipomoea purpurea*

Black Eyed Susan Vine = *Thunbergia alata*

Vinca = *Catharanthus roseus*

Gazania = *Gazania ringens*

Lamium (Spotted Dead Nettle) = *Lamium maculatum*

Sage = *Salvia microphylla*

**Note:** Some of these annuals may require more shade because of the hot, dry summers and the intensity of the sun.

This list is not nearly a complete list of all the annuals that can possibly be grown in the sun. Please check with your local nursery grower for additional and unique annuals.

Most annuals have similar water requirements; however, there are a few species which need more or less water, check with your local nursery grower for specific water requirements of each plant you have selected.
